2012 AOHT High School Scholarship Information

The Maui Hotel & Lodging Association's Academy of Hospitality & Tourism (AOHT) scholarship program is designed to promote the Visitor Industry as a career and profession in Hawaii; and to provide financial assistance to students whose chosen career path is within the Industry. The Scholarship Selection Committee grants preference to scholarship applicants who have participated in the Academy of Hospitality & Tourism program and whose major post-secondary educational objective is within the Hospitality and Tourism Industry. Other fields may be considered if they are related to the Visitor Industry.

Scholarships Available:

- \$500 - \$1,000

Eligibility Requirements - Applicants must be a high school senior and completed all the following items:

- Academy of Hospitality & Tourism 2-year program
- A minimum of 120 internship hours
- The UH Maui College IS105C Orientation to Employment Course

Application Procedure - Applicants must submit each of the following documents in one complete packet – incomplete packets will not be accepted:

- Part I: A completed Maui Hotel & Lodging Association Scholarship **Application Form**
- Part II: A **Personal Statement** from the applicant that details the values and benefits gained from their personal experiences in the AOHT program, how they would improve the program and why they are interested in the visitor industry.
- Part III: **Three Letters of Recommendation** from the following. Letters of recommendation from family members will **not** be accepted.
 1. AOHT Academy Teacher, *Required*
 2. Employer/Internship Sponsor, from Junior or Senior year, *Required*
 3. An individual who made an impact on their life. For example: Community leader, Church leader or Volunteer group leader.
- Part IV: A **Resume**
- Part V: A copy of 3rd Quarter **Report Card**
- Part VI: UH Maui College **transcript** for the IS105C Orientation to Employment Course
- Part VII: **Proof of completed internship** on company letterhead and signed by management of the location where internship took place.

Scholarship Selection Committee:

The Selection Committee is comprised of industry and community representatives – all of whom have a vested interest in workforce development. The identity of the committee members will NOT be made public.

Applicant Interview:

Upon review of all applications, the Selection Committee will decide on the top candidates. Those selected as a top candidate will be contacted for an interview with the Scholarship Selection Committee.

Application Deadline & Information:

Completed applications must be delivered by 4 pm **Wednesday, April 4, 2012** or post-marked no later than **Monday, April 2, 2012** to:

Notification:

Scholarship awards will be presented at the AOHT Graduation Luncheon held on **Tuesday, May 15, 2012**. Scholarship funds must be used to pay for tuition, books and school supplies by July 1, 2013. Proof of enrollment is required. Scholarship monies must be returned to the Maui Hotel & Lodging Association if the recipient is not enrolled in the Fall 2012/Spring 2013 college semesters.

3. An individual who made an impact on their life. For example: Community leader, Church leader or Volunteer group leader.

Part IV. Resume

Attach a resume summarizing your employment, education, extra-curricular activities, community service, accomplishments and awards.

Part V. Report Card

Attach a copy of your 3rd quarter report card.

Part VI. Transcript

Attach an official transcript of your UH Maui College IS105C Orientation to Employment

Part VII. Completed Internship

Attach a copy or statement verifying completion of 120 hours of internship program on company letterhead and signed by management
